Keeping Our Community Safe: Addressing Concerns Around Knife Crime

A Message from Our Safeguarding Team

Nationally and within our local communities, concerns surrounding knife crime involving teenagers are sadly on the rise. At the RNN Group, the safety of our learners is paramount, and we want to ensure all parents and students are well-informed and vigilant.

It's a dangerous misconception that carrying a weapon, such as a knife, offers personal protection. In fact, carrying a knife dramatically increases the risk of serious injury or fatal consequences for the individual, and for those around them.

The devastating impact of knife crime can be lifelong, affecting families and communities profoundly.

We want to reassure you that the RNN Group colleges are safe environments for learning and personal growth. We have robust safeguarding procedures in place, and any concerns raised about student safety will always be treated with the utmost seriousness and acted upon swiftly.

What You Can Do:

We urge all students and parents to remain vigilant. If you have any concerns about knife crime, or suspect a young person is carrying a weapon:

The Dangers of Youth Vaping:

While often perceived as a safer alternative to traditional cigarettes, vaping carries significant health risks, particularly for developing lungs and brains. E-liquids contain nicotine, a highly addictive substance that can harm adolescent brain development, impact memory and concentration, and lead to dependency. Beyond nicotine, vapes can contain other harmful chemicals and unknown substances.

A major concern is that young people often don't know what is truly in their vape.

There's a risk of products containing illegal or unregulated substances, such as **THC (the psychoactive component of cannabis)**, which can have unpredictable and dangerous effects on health. The sharing of vapes also poses serious hygiene risks and can spread illnesses.

Our College Environment & Support:

The RNN Group remains a safe and structured learning environment. **Vaping and smoking are strictly only permitted in designated outdoor areas on college premises.** We actively enforce this policy to maintain a healthy and respectful environment for all.

Beyond enforcement, our priority is to support our learners' health and well-being. We want to work collaboratively with students to ensure they understand the genuine health risks associated with vaping. Our aim is to provide comprehensive support for those who wish to stop vaping or need help to reduce their dependency.

Where to Find Advice and Support:

If you or your child have concerns about vaping, or if your child needs support to stop, please reach out. Our dedicated teams are here to help:

- Wellbeing Mentors: Available for confidential advice and guidance on health and well-being.

By understanding these new laws and the associated health risks, we can work together to support our young people in making informed and healthy choices.

Skills for Employment

We launched a brand new initiative - Skills for Employment - to all our learners this year.

This initiative - developed in partnership with a number of local businesses - helps to develop your young person into a first rate employee by working to complete ten 'power skills' / transferable skills that are in high demand by employers.

Employers will also support this by providing work experience or an industry placement to help gather the evidence required for each stamp and certificate that they will receive.
